## Brief Information on Principal China Multi Asset Income Fund

The Fund is a Wholesale Feeder Fund issued by Principal Malaysia, which aims to provide income and moderate capital growth through investments in one collective investment scheme, which invests primarily in a diversified portfolio of securities related to China. The Fund is established with a multi-class structure and is allowed to establish new Class(es) from time to time without your prior consent.

This is neither a capital protected fund nor a capital guaranteed fund.

### Product Suitability

The recommended investment timeframe for this Fund is five (5) years or more. This Fund best suits you if you:

- are a Sophisticated Investor;
- have a long term investment horizon;
- want exposure to securities related to China and is willing to accept moderate volatility associated with investments in a target fund investing in securities related to China which actively adjusts its investment exposures; and
- seek regular income.

## Avenues to Exit This Investment

Withdrawal can be made from the Fund by completing a withdrawal form and sending it to the relevant Distributor or our head office. There is no restriction on the frequency of withdrawals and no Withdrawal Fee will be charged. Hence, the amount that you will receive is the withdrawal value. You will be paid in the currency of the Class (e.g. Class USD Unit holders will be paid in USD) within seven (7) Business Days upon our receipt of the complete withdrawal request. You will have to bear the applicable bank fees and charges, if any.

Transfer Fee	- A nominal fee levied for each transfer of units from one (1) Unit holder to another.
Trust	- HSBC Collective Investment Trust, an umbrella unit trust established under the laws of Hong Kong by a trust deed dated 27 February 2014 between the Target Fund Manager and HSBC Institutional Trust Services (Asia) Limited as the Target Fund’s trustee.
Trustee Fee	- A fee that is paid to the Trustee for its services rendered as trustee of the Fund.
Unit holder	- The registered holder for the time being of a unit of the Fund including persons jointly so registered.
USD	- United States Dollar.
Wholesale Fund	- A unit trust scheme established in Malaysia where the units are to be issued, offered for subscription or purchase, or for which invitations to subscribe for or purchase the units are to be made, exclusively to Sophisticated Investor.
Withdrawal Fee	- A charge levied upon withdrawal under certain terms and conditions (if applicable).
